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

Summary of the report:

This report analyses the feedback provided by students regarding the curricular aspects, infrastructure of the College, quality of teaching, library facilities and overall ambience of our institution.

Methodology:

Structured feedback forms were distributed among students of mainly final year, covering various aspects of the curriculum. The responses were collected and analysed using a Likert scale from 'Strongly Agree' to 'Strongly Disagree'.

Key Findings:

- Majority of students gave positive feedback regarding the teaching-learning system, interaction with teachers both within and outside the lassroom
- Most students expressed satisfaction with course contents in terms of providing necessary skills for future employability and development in their chosen fields.

- providing necessary skills for future employability and development in their chosen fields.
 Almost all students were happy with the laboratory facilities they were able to access. Some students from Science departments have felt the need for more computers and internet connection.
 The learning environment of the college and teaching methodology adopted by most teachers were highly appreciated by students. They also appreciated the regular internal examinations.
 Students were very happy getting constant encouragement form the college to take part in various extra-curricular activities, like games & sports, cultural events, exhibitions, etc.
 Students also believe that there is scope for improvement in the general cleanliness level of the College. There has been a reiteration of the long-standing request for more classrooms.
 The Central Library could be improved in terms of adequate reading space and photocopying facilities.
 Most of the students appreciated the natural and green environment of the College, the security arrangements herein, anti-ragging initiatives, and the overall administration.

Summary of the report:

This report analyses the feedback provided by teachers regarding Syllabus, academic performance and ambience of the institution. The feedback aims to access the relevance and effectiveness of the curriculum in meeting different developmental meeting.

Methodology:

Structured feedback forms were distributed among teachers covering various aspects of the curriculum. The responses were scored on a five-point scale from 'Strongly Agree' to 'Strongly Disagree'.

Key Findings:

- Most teachers agreed that the curriculum was need based having well-defined

Report on Action taken on feedback analysis Academic Year: 2019-20

ACTION TAKEN

The feedback given by teachers, students and parents for the academic year 2019-2020 were analyzed. The College administration has been taking every possible measure in the global pandemic period COVID-19 to resolve most of the issues raised by students and parents which has been indicated in the action taken report below. The teachers who were part of the syllabus framing did attempt to bring about some changes in the syllabus. The college follows the guidelines laid down by the University of Gour Banga with respect to the syllabus.

1. The TIC interacted with the teachers and discussed all points that required attention as evident from students' feedback.

2. Proper and updated instruments as per requirement of the CBCS curriculum are provided to the students utilizing the RUSA 2.0 fund.

3. Teachers are taking classess **ONLINE** in the COVID-19 period for the benefit of the students. The timing of class routine has been revised for online classes. Attandance for teachers and students were taken through <u>Google form</u>.

4. Study materials and lecture notes (pdf, PPT, YouTube link) have been shared by many teachers with their students by forming small WhatsApp groups or through emails. And also the materials are uploaded in a dedicated web portal, cloud classroom of college website.

5. The number of dustbins has been increased and cleaners instructed to clean the campus more often and disinfectants to be used for prevention of mosquitoes. Cleaning of toilets, too, is being regularly monitored.

6. The NSS unit organized Campus Cleaning programmes.

7. While all drinking water units have been brought under the annual maintenance system, the college has plans to increase the number of such outlets.

8. More career guidance and soft skill development schemes have been implemented.

9. Departments have initiated steps to conduct seminars /conferences on skill enhancement / extension.
