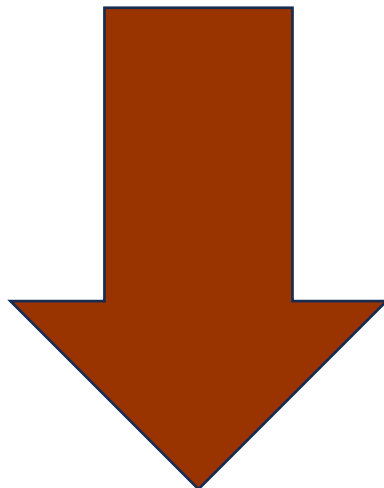

Introduction

On June 2, 2023, the Department of Education of Raiganj Surendranath Mahavidyalaya hosted a one-day Students Seminar by Semester VI, Education Honours for the partial fulfilment of the B.A Education Honours Degree at the University of Gour Banga, Malda. Report on Prevention of Suicide

Prevention of Suicide (25/11/22)

Dr. Subrata Ghosh, Assistant Professor of Economics,RSM conducted the event from the starting.

Mr. Sanat Singha, acting TIC for that day,RSM delivered the introductory speech. Being an Assistant Professor of Sociology, he emphasized the work of French sociologist, *Émile Durkheim* who is considered as one of the principal founders of modern sociology. In His book, *Suicide*(1897), Durkheim explained suicide *sociologically* by exploring the differing suicide rates and according to him incidence of suicide is mostly the results of variation among social environments, not the suicides of particular individuals.

There were TWO Resource Persons on that event.

1.Dr. Bidyut Banerjee,*Assistant Professor of Community Medicine* differed somewhat with the previous speaker's view and stressed upon the fact that suicide is very much related to individual's mental situation. Indeed it is a disease from a doctor's point of view. The impact of suicide in communities makes suicide a serious public health problem. Suicide is one of the leading causes of death. But He assured this disease is preventable too. Knowing the risk factors and recognizing the warning signs for suicide can help prevent suicide.

2. Tanaya Sengupta, *Psychiatric social worker* assists and supports patients who suffer from conditions such as depression, severe anxiety, and psychotic or substance-related disorders.

She explained that individual, relationship, community and societal factors can increase the risk of suicide .

What You Can Do

The Resource Parsons suggested five steps to take to support a loved one that may be experiencing suicidal thoughts.

- **Ask someone** you are concerned about if they're thinking about suicide. Studies show that asking someone if they are having thoughts of suicide does not increase the likelihood of a completed suicide nor does it increase suicidal thoughts.
- **Be there for them.** This could be by phone or in person.
- **Keep them safe.** Reduce access to lethal means for those at risk.
- **Help them connect** with ongoing support.
- **Follow up.** Give them a call or visit. Send a text or an email to let them know that you are still present.

Vote of thanks was given by Dr. Simul Chandra Sarkar, Department of Bengali, RSM, and lastly he declared the end of the programme.

Workshop Agenda: The workshop commenced at 12 noon and continued until 3:00 PM. The agenda included:



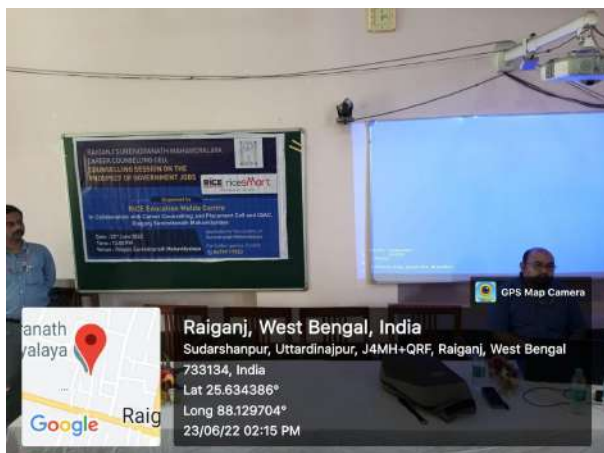

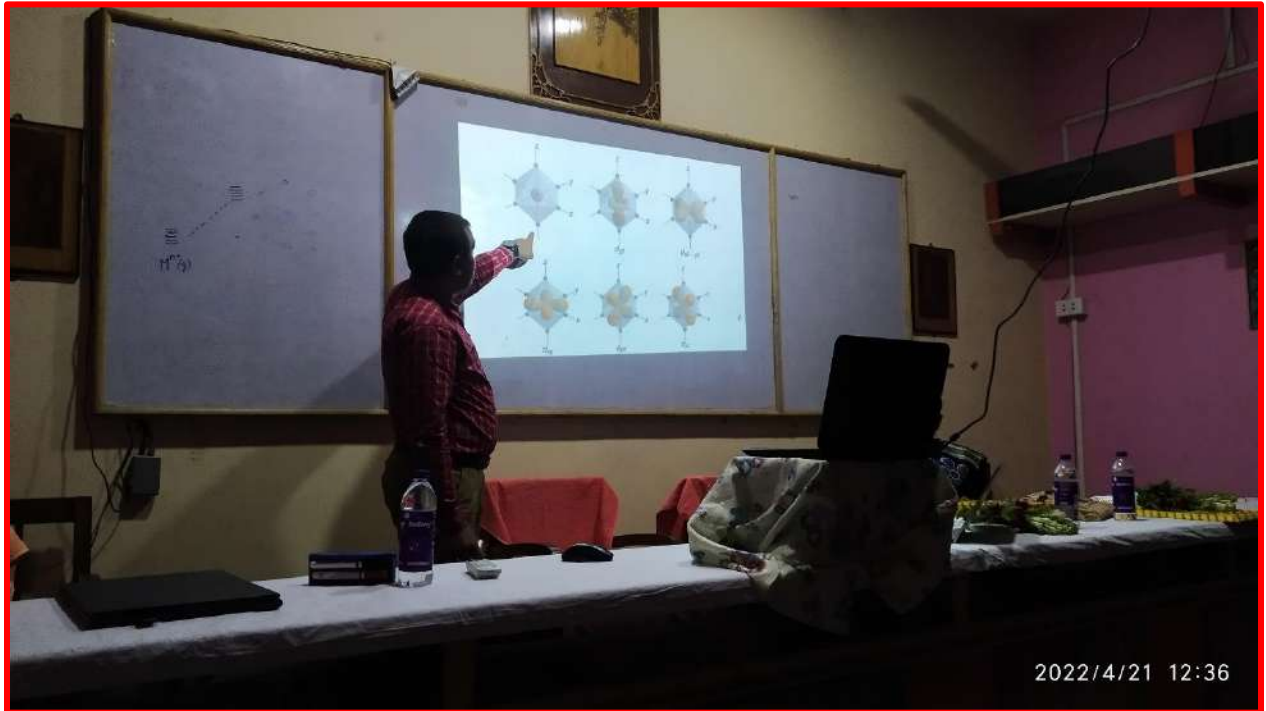

Introduction

Patriarchy, as a system of social organization that privileges men over women, is deeply ingrained in various aspects of everyday life. Negotiating patriarchy involves navigating its structures, norms, and expectations, often influencing personal relationships, work dynamics, and societal roles. This seminar report delves into the nuanced ways individuals engage with and challenge patriarchy in their daily lives.

On March 24, 2022, the Women's Cell of Raiganj Surendranath Mahavidyalaya, in collaboration with IQAC, organised a Seminar on "*Negotiating Patriarchy in Everyday Life*" to commemorate *International Women's Day on March 8, 2022*. 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community organising, and grassroots activism. The Speaker also invited participants to share personal tales of confronting patriarchal norms in their families, communities, and workplaces, emphasising the importance of small-scale efforts to impact larger social change.

Participants from diverse disciplines, as well as the faculty and non-teaching community of Raiganj Surendranath Mahavidyalaya, exhibited active engagement and involvement during the interactive session, reflecting the Seminar's true core.

Conclusion

Dr. Nilima Moktan, Convener of the Women Cell of Raiganj Surendranath Mahavidyalaya, concluded the seminar by stating that the event was an opportunity for all in the context of addressing patriarchy in everyday life. She went on to say that establishing an inclusive community can help create a more equitable and just society for all genders. This Seminar serves as a beginning point for future discussion and action to dismantle patriarchy in all of its forms.

A Report on “International Women’s Day” Celebration on 12th March 2021

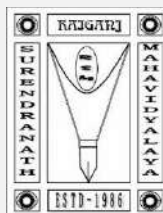



- b. Recognition of the relevance of Swami Vivekananda's educational philosophy in contemporary times.
- c. Inspiration and motivation for educators, students, and policymakers to integrate his principles into their educational endeavors.
- d. Exchange of ideas and experiences among participants, fostering a collective commitment towards holistic education and societal transformation.
