
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3.4.1: Outcomes of Extension activities in the neighborhood community in terms of impact and sensitizing the students to social issues for their holistic development during the last five years.

Raiganj Surendranath Mahavidyalaya aims to inculcate all the stakeholders particularly the students and neighbourhood community a sense of social responsibility through various Awareness programs and extension activities, so that they become conscious of prevalent social ills. Our college has started to take initiative for various extension activity related programmes, initially though the number of such programme was relatively less but gradually year by year we have successfully organized many more such programmes. This initiative not only taken by NSS unit of our college but also some other units such as Women Cell, Health Club, Nature Club have energetically worked on it. Besides our internal unit the external collaborative unit who have come forward and make a profound impact on such activities with joint hand are the various Government and Non-Government Organizations (NGOs).

To regulate these issues, College has organized: various programmes such as:

- Anti-Drug and No Tobacco Campaign
- Social awareness programs on health and hygiene:
- Blood donation camp
- Drug Abuse and Illicit Trafficking programme
- Awareness Programme on Tree Plantation and Rally
- Programme on Awareness about Green Campus
- Awareness Programme on AIDS day
- Seminar programme on "Prevention of Suicide"
- Cancer Awareness Programme
- Free Education camp for under-privileged children were conducted in neighbouring slum areas to give them rudimentary education, familiarizing them with basic English and vernacular vocabulary along with elementary Mathematics through play way methods.







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- Campaigns for prevention of communicable diseases were carried out in collaboration with the Students' Health Home, through organizing rallies and displaying awareness poster in the locality focusing on
- Youth Parliament competition (YPC): students from different department participate and sensitize by such programmes (programme is held at different colleges and in our college)
- Distribution of food and clothes & Blankets were carried out in the neighbouring slum area, forest area and outside hospitals distribution of mask and sanitizer during the lockdown period.
- Dengue Awareness programme
- The Save Water Campaign was carried out in the surrounding area of the institution to stop the wastage of water by installing taps on open water pipes
- Various **Community Engagement Programs** were organised by the students of the institution involving people of the locality in the developmental activities in the following areas
- Gender Sensitization Initiative by Gender Audit

While talking about outcome of such programme we must say as per our observation that the involvement of number of students gradually increased in such programmes in many social issues that help to develop the students holistically. For example, students who have never donated their blood progressively come forward in such noble activities. Significant contribution also observed in tree plantation programme where the student's voluntary come forward for such programmes and planted enormous tree in various places of our societies. In the mission of clean and green or **Swach Bharat Abhiyan** our college once received Green Award (2022), which encourage a lot of students to clean the campus and to make the environment green as far as possible.

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



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

ACTIVITIES UNDERTAKEN ON 3RD JUNE 2023

Event no: 1 - Campus cleaning drive




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
The 'Green Team' of Organizers



Report on Road Safety Awareness Programme (Safe Drive Save Life) Organized by NSS Unit 2, Raiganj Surendra Nath Mahavidyalaya

Date: 22/12/2022

Introduction: The National Service Scheme (NSS) Unit 2 of Raiganj Surendra Nath Mahavidyalaya conducted a Road Safety Awareness Programme, titled "Safe Drive Save Life," on 22nd December 2022. 




