As a result of these efforts, the committee had not received a single complaint related to ragging and the campus continued to conduct regular awareness campaign about the issue to maintain a safe and welcoming environment for all students.

ANNUAL REPORT 2022-23

The Anti Ragging Cell was newly constructed under the TIC Dr. Abhinandan Das (1-12-2021 to 31-05-2022). Objectives of the Anti Ragging Cell was defined during this phase. The members of the Cell decided and finalized Anti Ragging Regulations for the institution, in accordance with the prevailing regulations of various statutory bodies. It was decided to conduct Anti Ragging Cell meeting every month, or in case of any complaint registered— as and when basis.

It was also decided to ensure submission of undertaking in the prescribed format from the candidate concerned on anti-ragging at the time of admission. Anti Ragging Cell organized different awareness campaign throughout the year. In the meeting decisions have been taken to suggest measures to tighten vigil against any act which constitutes ragging. This measure helped for prevention of ragging and made the campus a ragging free zone.

Raiganj Surendranath Mahavidyalaya attempted to adopt measures for prohibition of ragging to eliminate the scourge of ragging as per the definition given— in the relevant regulations, including the formation of the Anti-Ragging Squad, Mentoring Cell on ragging etc. As a result of these endeavours, the Cell had not received any complaint of ragging and the campus remained a ragging free zone which is conducive to academic growth and development.

After the appointment of the new Principal, Dr. Chandan Roy, the old Anti-Ragging Cell was revitalized with some minor changes and additions. An Anti-Ragging Squad was also established, consisting of students tasked with monitoring the behavior of their peers. The Cell began its work by conducting regular awareness campaigns and putting up Anti-Ragging posters across the campus.

Efforts were made to ensure that undertakings in the form of affidavits were obtained from students, parents, guardians, and staff members of the institute. The Cell's Convenor, Dr. Sujoy Ghosh, held regular meetings with members to ensure that all actions taken were in accordance with the guidelines set forth by the relevant regulatory bodies. Both the Cell and the Anti-Ragging Squad worked diligently to prevent and eliminate incidents of ragging within the college premises. Raiganj Surendranath Mahavidyalaya has committed to creating a safe and supportive environment for students by strictly enforcing a zero-tolerance policy towards ragging. It has also made significant efforts to comply with UGC regulations and the West Bengal Educational Act of 1983 regarding ragging prevention. The institution focuses on sensitizing students about the harmful effects of ragging and the potential disciplinary actions against offenders.
