





Introduction:

An educational trip to Padmaja Naidu Himalayan Zoological park was organized by the Department of Zoology, Raiganj Surendranath Mahavidyalaya on 4th April to 8th April 2023 to help the Zoology (Major) Semester-VI students to better understand bio-diversity conservation.

Mr. Debajit Chakraborty, Assistant Professor of Department of Zoology, RSM and Mr. Biswanath Das, Laboratory Attendant of Zoology Department guided the entire trip. PadmajaNaidu Himalayan Zoological Park is a 27.3 ha conservation area with average elevation of 2134m. One of the specialties of this park is the breeding animals in Alpine condition. It is one the Zoological parks where breeding programs for snow leopard, Himalayan wolf and redpanda are going on. It is also the central hub for Zoological Authority of India for red panda conservation program.

Established back in 14th August 1958, under the Department of Education, West Bengal, it has been a premiere place for conservation of Himalayan flora and fauna. Since, 1972, this Zoological garden became a registered society, the maintenance of which is borne by State and Central Government. This is the off-display breeding center for snow leopard, Himalayan wolf and red panda. Captive breeding of snow leopard started here back in 1983. The red panda program started in1994. Besides, this Zoo is the breeding center for Himalayan tahr, blue sheep, Himalayan monal, Himalayan salamander, grey peacock and blood pheasant.

During this trip, the students have collected knowledge about the habit, habitat, geographical distribution, and breeding strategies of the following animals and birds:

- Animals: Leopard cat, Asian palm civet, jungle cat, Mishmi takin, barking deer, royal Bengal tiger, Asiatic black bear, yak, Himalayan wolf, black panther, snow leopard.
- Birds: Golden pheasant, silver pheasant, lady Amherst pheasant, macaw.

The students acquired detailed theoretical knowledge and witnessed real life practices related to red panda conservation.

Project Red Panda:

Red panda is a small mammal of Himalayas, almost of jungle cat size, with chestnut coat colour, and ringed tail. It is distributed across the entire Himalayan belt upto Burma.

Initially categorized as threatened animal by habitat loss, deforestation, increased poaching. Although, this animal receives protection through Indian Wild Life Protection Act (1972); in 2006, IUCN enlisted this animal as endangered.

As a part of global captive breeding project and master plan, red panda conservation project was initiated in this Zoo back in 1994. Since then, by captive breeding new baby pandas are produced in this Zoo on regular basis. Currently, there are twenty- one healthy panda in this Zoo.




