Objectives of the Seminar



Prevention of Suicide (25/11/22)

Dr. Subrata Ghosh, Assistant Professor of Economics,RSM conducted the event from the starting.

Mr. Sanat Singha, acting TIC for that day,RSM delivered the introductory speech. Being an Assistant Professor of Sociology, he emphasized the work of French socilogist, <u>Émile Durkheim</u> who is considered as one of the principal founders of modern sociology. In His book, <u>Suicide</u>(1897), Durkheim explained suicide sociologically by exploring the differing suicide rates and according to him incidence of suicide is mostly the results of variation among <u>social environments</u>, not the suicides of particular individuals.

There were TWO Resource Persons on that event.

1.Dr. Bidyut Banerjee, Assistant Professor of Community Medicine differed somewhat with the previous speaker's view and streesed upon the fact that suicide is very much related to individual's mental situation. Indeed it is a disease from a doctor's point of view. The impact of suicide in communities makes suicide a serious public health problem. Suicide is one of the leading causes of death. But He assured this disease is preventable too. Knowing the risk factors and recognizing the warning signs for suicide can help prevent suicide.

2. Tanaya Sengupta, *Psychiatric social worker* assists and supports patients who suffer from conditions such as depression, severe anxiety, and psychotic or substance-related disorders.

She explained that individual, relationship, community and societal factors can increase the risk of suicide .

What You Can Do

The Resource Parsons suggested five steps to take to support a loved one that may be experiencing suicidal thoughts.

- Ask someone you are concerned about if they're thinking about suicide. Studies show that asking someone if they are having thoughts of suicide does not increase the likelihood of a completed suicide nor does it increase suicidal thoughts.
- **Be there for them.** This could be by phone or in person.
- **Keep them safe.** Reduce access to lethal means for those at risk.
- **Help them connect** with ongoing support.
- **Follow up.**Give them a call or visit. Send a text or an email to let them know that you are still present.










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Workshop Programme Report [23/06/2022]






Report Career Counselling & Guidance Program



Introduction

Patriarchy, as a system of social organization that privileges men over women, is deeply ingrained in various aspects of everyday life. Negotiating patriarchy involves navigating its structures, norms, and expectations, often influencing personal relationships, work dynamics, and societal roles. This seminar report delves into the nuanced ways individuals engage with and challenge patriarchy in their daily lives.
