Raiganj Surendranath Mahavidyalaya, established in 1986, caters to the needs of higher education predominantly for the SC, Minority, OBC and ST population of the Uttar Dinajpur district and seven out of ten students belonged to the socially deprived and economically challenged families. The college got accredited (B+ in 1st cycle) by NAAC in December 2016 and thereafter in October 2018 the college got selected for getting Rs. 2 crores as infrastructure development grant from RUSA 2.0 under Component-9 for the purpose of 1) New Construction 2) Renovation/Upgradation of old infrastructure and 3) Procurement for office, classrooms and laboratories, etc. So far college has received Rs. 1.5 crore. The college remains grateful and thankful to RUSA for the grant. The college authority remained responsible in making proper utilization of the RUSA fund in conformity with the Detailed Project Report (2018) submitted to RUSA. 1) New Construction

The college authority of Raiganj Surendranath Mahavidyalaya has given the contract of part construction of Ground floor of New Academic Building (with G+2 foundation) under RUSA 2.0 scheme, category-I, Creation of New Facilities to the PWD Social Sector, Raiganj Division in 2021. The PWD has recently initiated the Tender process in August 2024.

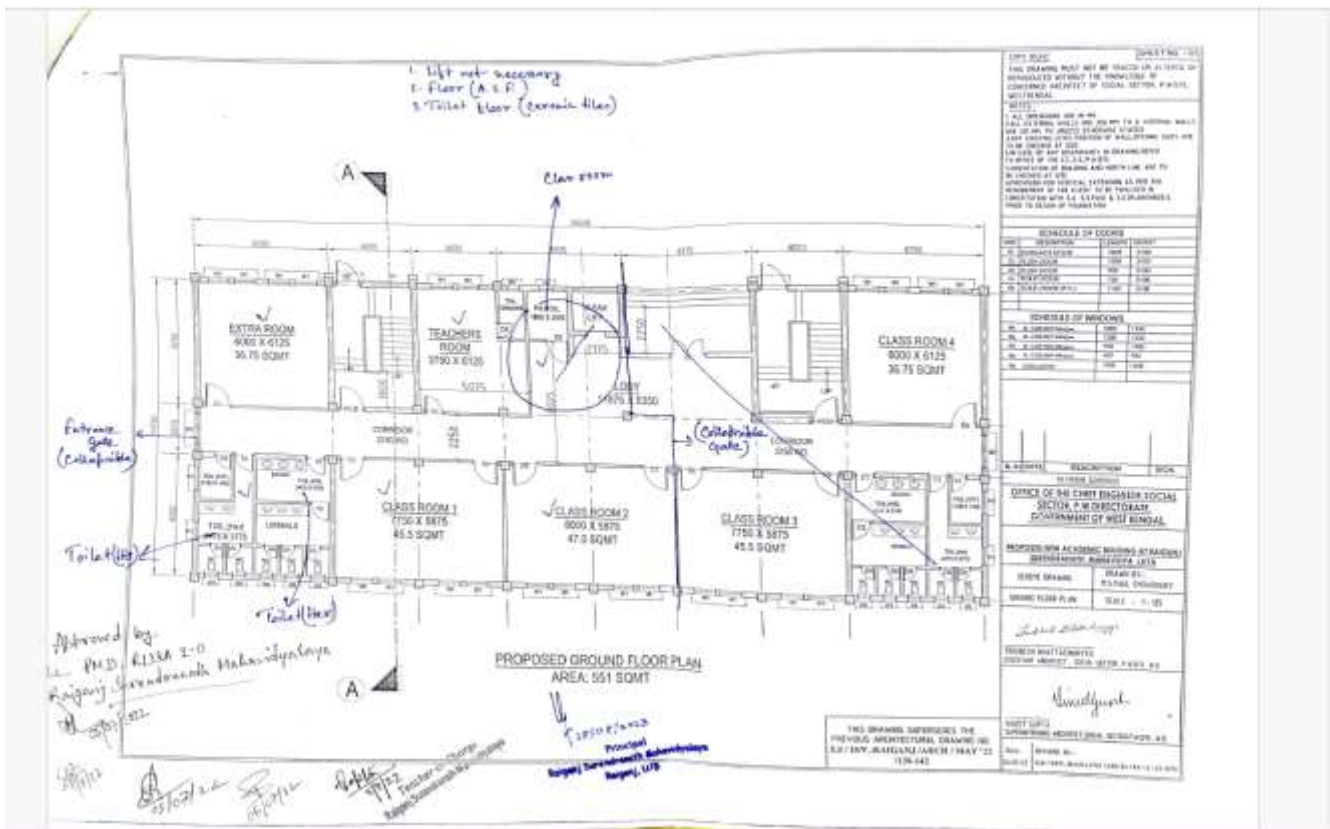

2) Renovation/Upgradation

The college building although not dilapidated was fast decaying as chronic problem of rain water seepage started to

1. damage the roofs and walls in the 2nd floor, 1st floor and ground floor
2. put the conference room, science laboratories and classrooms in shambles
3. cause serious damage of the electrical wirings in the water damped walls

Therefore, being endowed with the RUSA renovation fund the college decided to spend Rs 4038582/- (projected cost 20.19% as per DPR) towards making necessary treatment of the entire roof of the college main building with the objective to prevent seepage of rain water into the college main building. The college authority also decided to plaster and paint of outside wall, renovation of students common room and part of corridor in ground floor, renovation of entire students toilet area and part of staff toilet, renovation of a cafeteria seating area adjacent to students canteen, upgradation of unused store room into drinking water room, complete renovation of existing auditorium (Milanayatan) and science laboratories (Chemistry, Physics, Botany, Zoology, Mathematics), up-gradation of a 5kw grid connected solar plant, up-gradation of class rooms and office with LED tube and required ceiling fans.

During the FY 2020-21 and FY 2022-23 the college has spent Rs. 3693976/- through PWD and 100% work has been completed.

Outcome - The entire building is now free from rain water seepage and the building has obtained a new lease of life and it is expected that the college main building would survive for another 50 years or more. The old college building is now having a new look and the teaching learning ambience is improving.

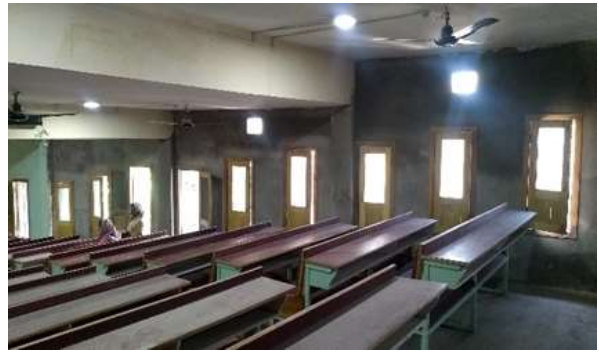

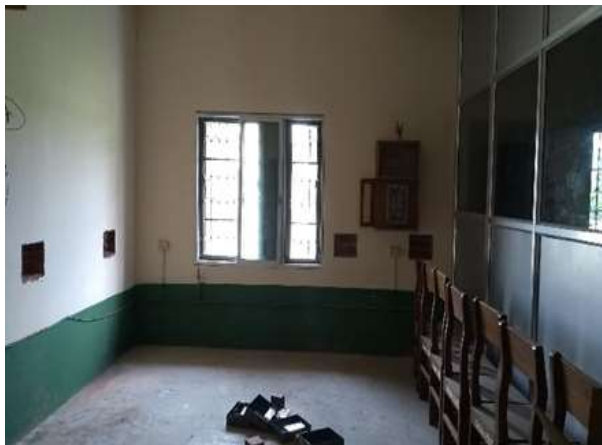
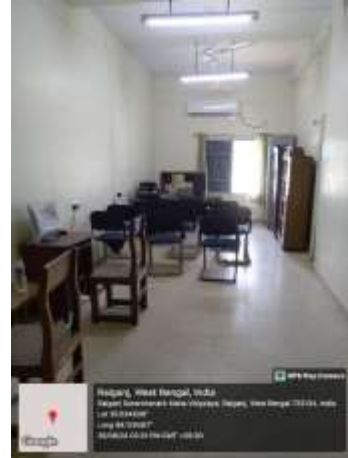

 - ❖ **Lab Equipment:** Rs. 13,32,100.00
Outcome – These procurements have enabled significant upgradation of the Chemistry laboratory, Physics laboratory, Botany Laboratory and the Zoology laboratory thereby fulfilling the recommendations of the NAAC Peer Team during the 1st cycle assessment.


